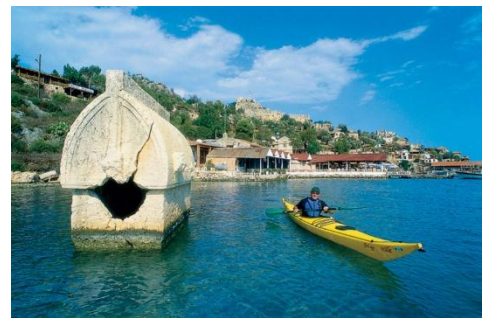

- ❖ integer programming, global optimization, stochastic integer programming, multi-objective programming.
